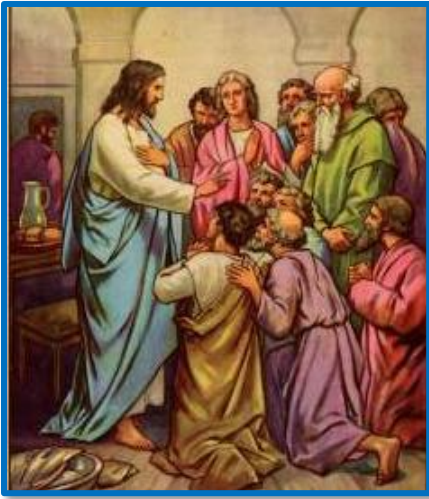

We are seeking those among you who are interested in planning and participating in the upcoming Men's Cursillo Weekends.

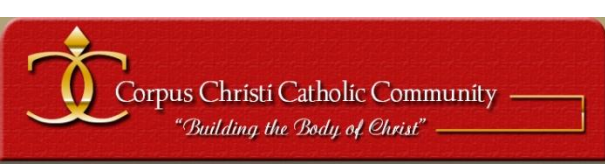

Saturday August 21st from 8:00-11:00 am

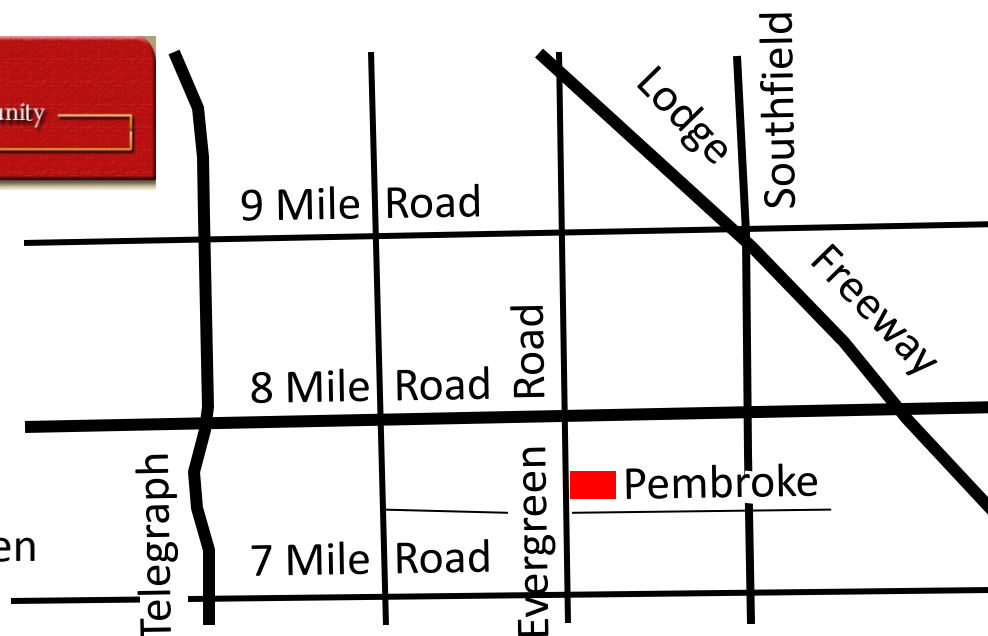


